Pitching, Strikeouts, Walks	Strikeouts as per normal Little League rules when a player is pitching	Coach pitch at all times, after defined number of strikes (called or swinging) then go to Tee.
	Walks are not allowed. If a count reaches 4 balls or if a batter is hit by a pitch, a coach from the batting team will come and the count will reset to 0 strikes. Swinging strikes only. A pitch from a coach is considered a ball unless batter swings.	
	For the first two games, use "scrimmage" rules: instead of allowing Ks, let's get all the kids some hits to start the season. That is, have a same-team coach comes out to pitch if a count reaches strike 3.	
Pitching requirements	Pitch count rules as outlined in minors. Ideally we are rotating the pitcher every inning though if/as possible.	N/A

Extra bases	1 base on an overthrow, extra bases on hits Fielders may choose to attempt a play after the overthrow, but, assuming the runner is safe, the play ends immediately after that one base after the initial error is made. This is an important detail as it keeps plays from getting out of hand at this age level.	No bases on overthrow.

Leadoff hitters	Every kid should have a chance to bat leadoff during the course of the season
